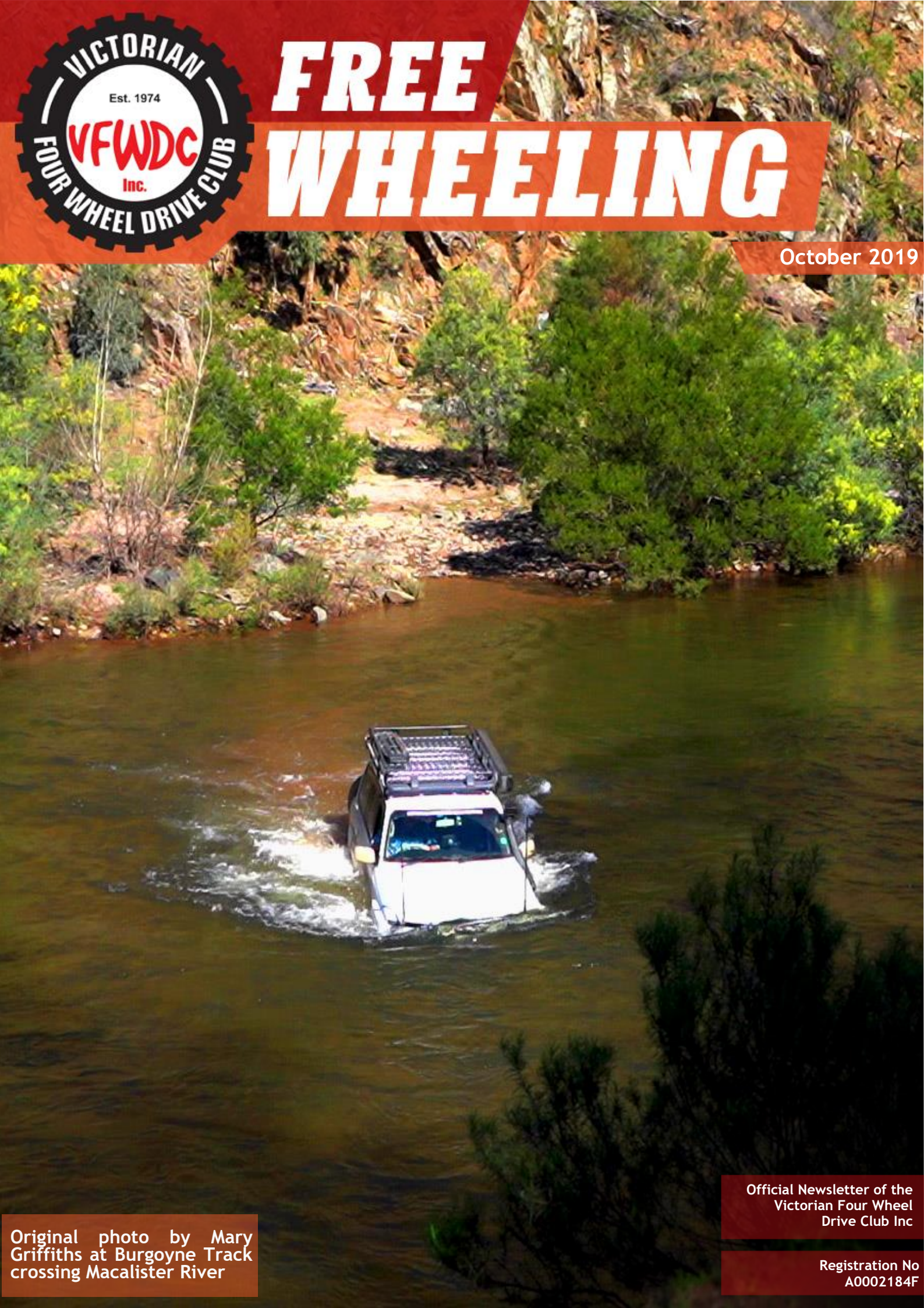

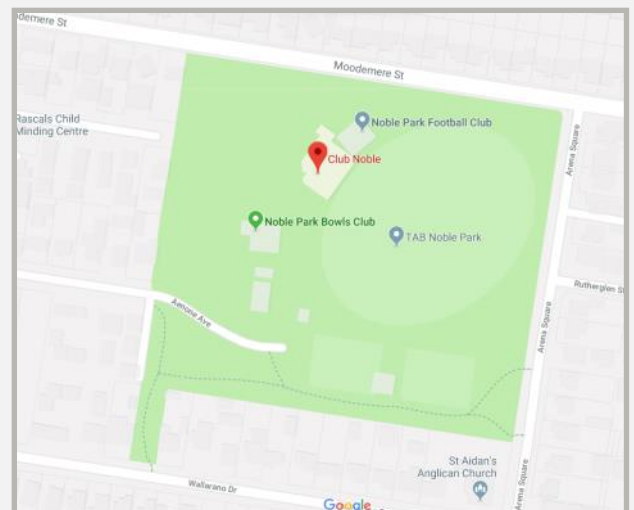
### VFWDC General Meeting Venue

## PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Hi all,

I'm sure that almost everyone in our club would be aware of the dreadful event that unfolded along Trigg Track last month. As fellow four wheel drive enthusiasts, I am sure that we all wish to pass on our heartfelt condolences and sympathy for the affected families and friends of Caleb and Shannon who both tragically lost their lives in a severe rollover.

While the news of their fate is extremely saddening, this was by most accounts an avoidable tragedy. There may be some very sobering lessons for us all to take from this and to reflect upon:

- Four wheel driving can be dangerous and we should always try to minimise the risks;
- Get in touch with local rangers and authorities before heading away;
- Consider your vehicle set up and driving skills/experience before attempting difficult terrain;
- Take note of, and respect, all track closures (including unseasonal and ungated closures);
- Consider installing a cargo barrier to improve vehicle rollover strength and occupant safety;
- Avoid travelling alone, always tell someone where you are going and use a 'ground charlie';
- Consider carrying a registered personal locating beacon whenever you travel.

On a much more positive note, I would like to thank the team at Safety Dave for attending and supporting our Club at our last general meeting. For anyone that missed out, the team at Safety Dave have agreed to hold open their advertised discounts for any of our Club members who couldn't attend or place an order with them at our last meeting. All members are encouraged to carry an appropriate first aid kit with them on Club events, particularly when travelling with children or through remote areas.

Later this month we have our next Club working bee scheduled for the Aberfeldy area and surrounding district. We would love to see as many people who can come along to this event. It is not just all about work (usually we squeeze in some play time too) and the more hands on deck, the easier it becomes for all. So if you can spare the time, please come along to help out, learn and explore in the knowledge that our Club plays an important role in preserving the rich history of this area.

Until I see you next, take care, keep safe and remember to tread lightly.

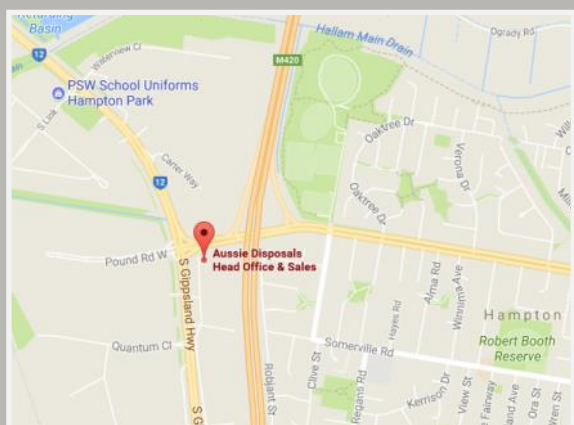
